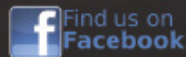

Hearing Evaluation

Our licensed Audiologist are trained to perform a battery of tests to help determine your ability to hear and interrupt sound. It all starts with a thorough history, and visual examination of the ear canal and eardrum. Audiology of Tulsa is equipped to perform hearing evaluations on patients of all ages, and with all types of hearing issues.

Hearing Aids

We offer a wide variety of hearing aids for all types of hearing loss. We most work with hearing aid manufacturers such as Widex and GN ReSound. All hearing aids are fit under a thirty day trial period. Bi-weekly recheck visits are scheduled during this time to verify that the hearing aids are meeting your needs. Annual hearing evaluations and follow up visits are also encouraged to ensure that we are continuing to meet your hearing healthcare needs.

Hearing Aid Accessories

Many accessories are available to help enhance your hearing in certain environments and with your mobile devices. Ask your audiologist which accessory is right for you.

Routine Hearing Aid Maintenance and Aural Rehabilitation

It is important to have your hearing aids inspected and cleaned every four to six months. Our hearing aid laboratory is equipped to perform microscopic cleaning and minor repairs to your hearing aids as well as answer any questions about the use of your hearing aids. Our lab technicians are available during normal business hours. Calling ahead to help us anticipate your arrival is encouraged.
